Documents

For entitlement to reduced registration fees, proof of sterilisation, microchip implant, membership of an approved association, obedience papers, breeding license, statutory declaration or tax return for proof of working dog status is required.

Excess Animal Permits

Permits must be obtained to keep more than 2 dogs or more than 2 cats per residential premises.

Restricted Breeds

The following restricted breeds must be declared:

1. American Pitbull Terrier or Pitbull Terrier
2. Dogo Argentino
3. Fila Brasileiro
4. Japanese Tosa
5. Perro de Presa Canario or Presa Canario

Penalties

Owners of unregistered animals may receive on-the-spot fines for each animal. Random spot checks will occur after 10 April.

Certificate of Registration

Once your registration fee is paid this notice will be deemed to be your certificate of registration. Your current registration tag is not valid until payment is made.

Registration Refunds
