



**INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED
WHEN AN APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMIT FOR
ANIMAL KEEPING (GREYHOUNDS)**

When submitting an application for Planning Permit, three (3) copies of the following information is to be submitted along with a completed application form:

1. A detailed site layout plan, including elevations, drawn to an appropriate scale showing the location of all pens, runs and buildings on the site.
2. Full details of all landscaping, included the type and location of all plants and the type of ground surface treatment (i.e. lawn, sand, concrete, gravel etc.).
3. Details of the height, style and location of all fences.
4. Details of lighting.
5. Materials of construction of all kennels and buildings associated with the use including type and method of insulation.
6. Number of greyhounds to be kept on the site and the proposed number of litters per year.
7. Details of exercising and training which will occur on the site.
8. Details of all stormwater and drainage associated with the facility.
9. Method of waste collection, storage and disposal.
10. Details as to whether boarding of greyhounds not belonging to the applicant will take place, including the number and frequency of turnover etc.
11. A brief written explanation as to how the facility will be managed, including details of proposed feeding and training times.
12. A full copy of the title including any restrictive covenants.
13. An application fee of \$440. (This is an application fee and not a Permit fee. If Council does not support the application, the fee is non-refundable.)
